WHAT WE ARE UP TO

Through our Foundation, along with participating partners, we are preparing for our first hockey camp - Miracles on Icesm. The camp is scheduled for August 6-10 and will be open to 30 at-risk boys and girls ranging in ages from 9-11. Each day will begin at 8am and end at 5pm and consist of two to three ice sessions, outdoor dry land training, daily classroom sessions of math and geography, motivational speakers and on the final day, an intra-squad game.

VOLUNTEERS

In this issue, we would like to highlight our volunteer coaching team. Our head coach, John McKibbon, has played hockey for over 30 years and is the winningest coach in high school hockey in Colorado. He currently coaches the Ralston Valley High School Hockey Team in Arvada, Colorado. Coach McKibbon also is the owner/director of Power Play Unlimited, which sponsors summer programs to develop hockey players at all levels and ages with over 200 participants annually. He also serves as the director of hockey operations for Arvada Hockey. Our assistant coach, Lincoln Coverdale, has played hockey since he was 3 years old. He currently serves as Youth Hockey Manager for the University of Denver overseeing 19 teams. He is responsible for the development of players, teams and the overall program. We are so fortunate to have both John and Lincoln contribute their expertise to this program.
